

Genesis 12:7







Isaac




Jacob

Worksheet

- Colour in the figures and cut them out. These are your counters.


Rules of the Game:

- Roll the dice to start, the player who rolls the highest number begins.
- Roll the dice and move your counter the same number of spaces.
- First player to the Promised Land wins.



Special numbers:

- 6 = Cross the Red Sea, accelerate to 14.
- 11 = You've been hit by the plague of flies, go back to 8.
- 23 = You've been hit by the plague of frogs, go back to 17
- 29 = Cross the Jordan River, accelerate to 38.
- 35 = You've been hit by the Lice Plague, go back to 31.
- 41 = You've been hit by the Hail Plague, go back to 27.
